
I was speaking with former Mayor Joe Metelski in early April and the subject of the environmental successes at the Willow School were discussed. Joe mentioned that he had met you after a presentation you gave for the Upper Raritan Watershed Association and suggested I write to you.

The Willow School has been operating for several years and is now entering phase II planned growth. During this time, the performance of the school's wet lands management and waste water treatment have been monitored on a regular frequency by both the licensed engineering firm and the NJDEP. I have heard nothing but positive results and have recently learned that nitrate nitrogen levels of septic effluent leaving the biological treatment has been reduced to less than 0.5 mg/l prior to discharge to subsequent treatment.

I believe that the work your firm performs is on the leading edge of improved technology for our environment.

The Bedminster Board of Health is currently looking at advanced wastewater treatment methods and we plan to invite you to a meeting for an update on Willow School and other projects you may be working on in the township.
